9. New Business continued:
Summer Park Maintenance: The board recommended that we use personnel on staff to care for park . The bids from last year were high and with cost of fuel it is expected that they would increase beyond what we allocated. Conversations will be had with existing personnel and a decision can be made at the next meeting. Terry offered his services and use of his equipment if needed.

Water Hazard Sign: Trustee Biron announced that a sign has been donated that will display the Health Department determination of the Water Conditions. The sign is to be placed in the Park. There was discussion about similar information being made available at the ferry, but the location was to be discussed with EUPTA
